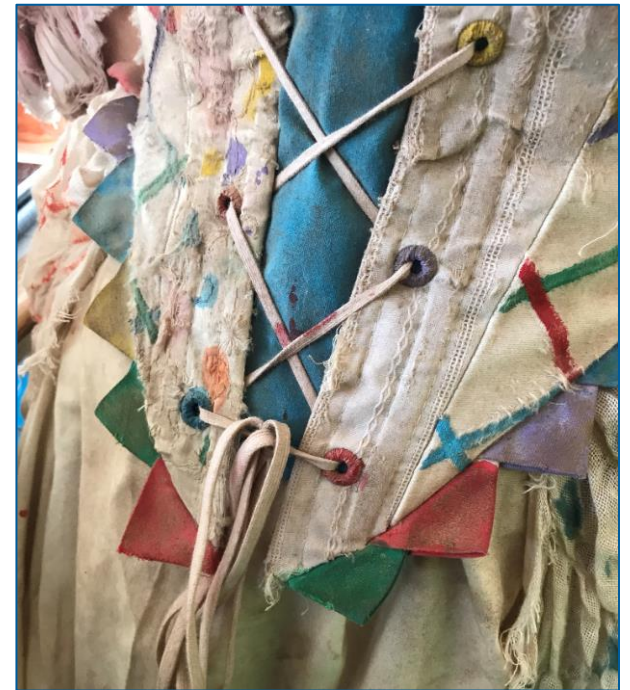

A Horror circus themed collaboration creating a perfume advert.

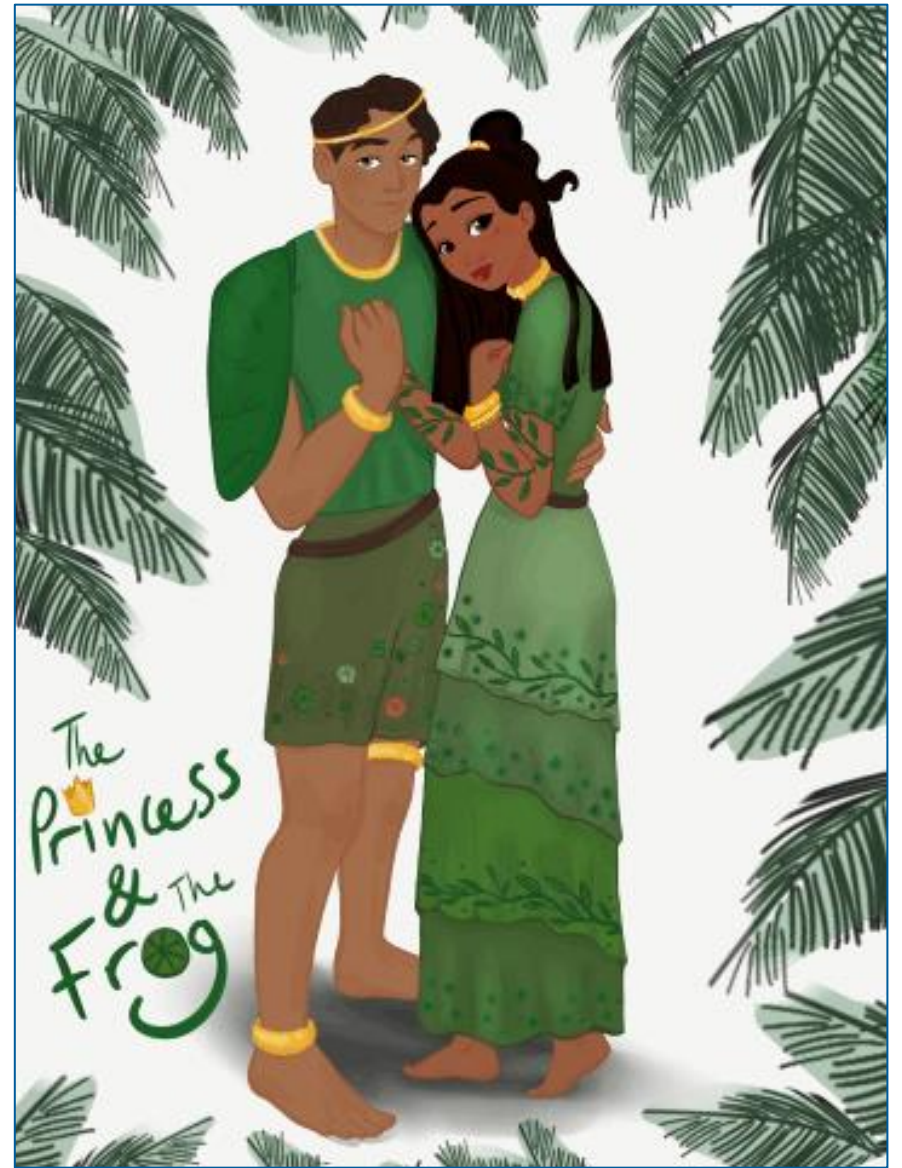

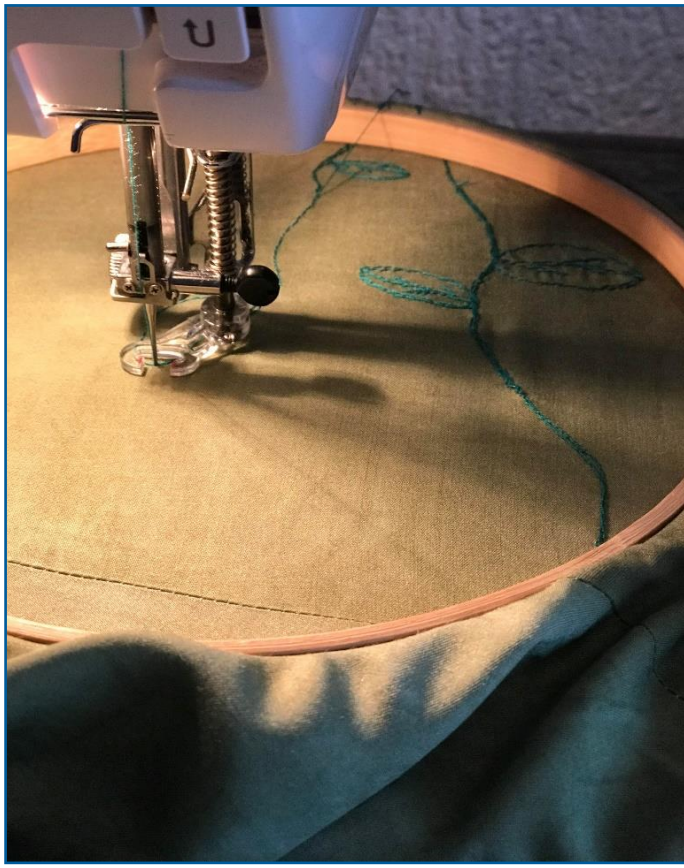

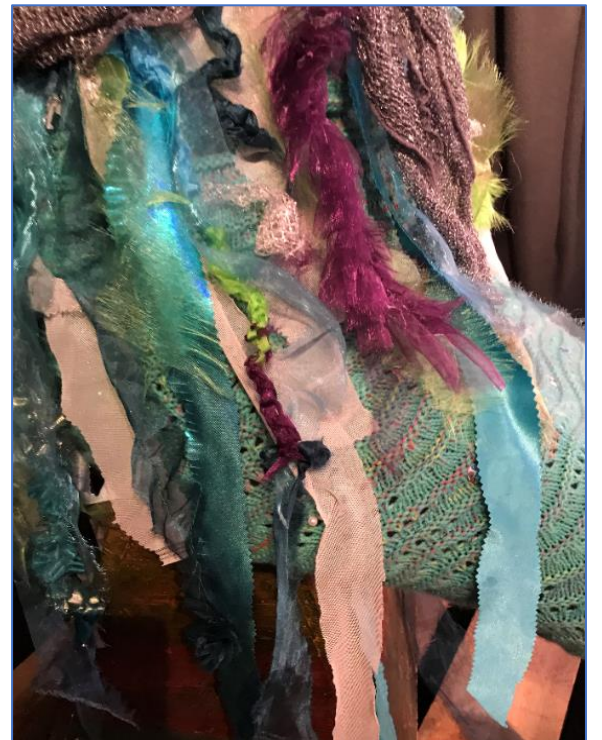

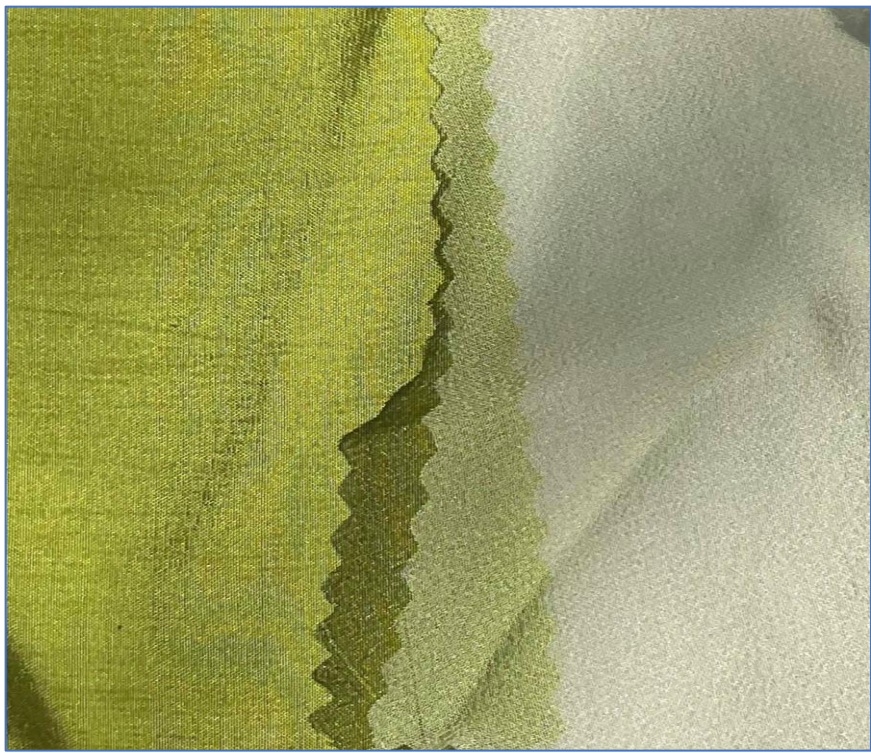
